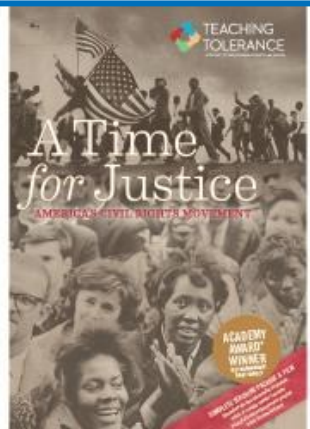


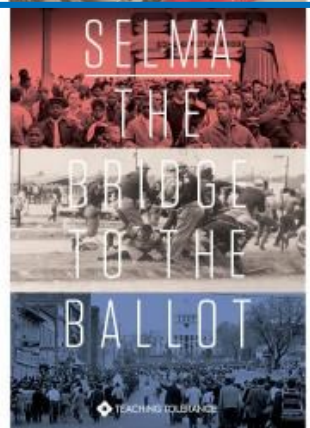

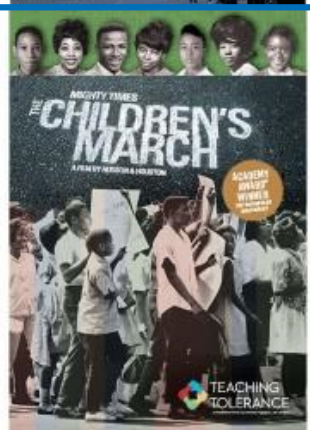
A Time for Justice
