To see if you qualify for Lifeline Service, please bring the following two items:

1. A government-issued ID or Matricula Consular Card.
2. Proof of benefit enrollment (see below) or proof of income.

Qualifying Public Assistance Programs:

- CalFresh, Food Stamps or Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance or Section 8
- Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)
- Medicaid/Medi-Cal (not Medicare)
- National School Lunch Program's (NSLP) free lunch program
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Women, Infants and Children Program (WIC)
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF):
 1. California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKS)
 2. Stanislaus County Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (StanWORKS)
 3. Welfare-to-Work (WTW)
 4. Greater Avenues for Independence (GAIN)
- Federal Veterans and Survivors Pension Benefit Program
