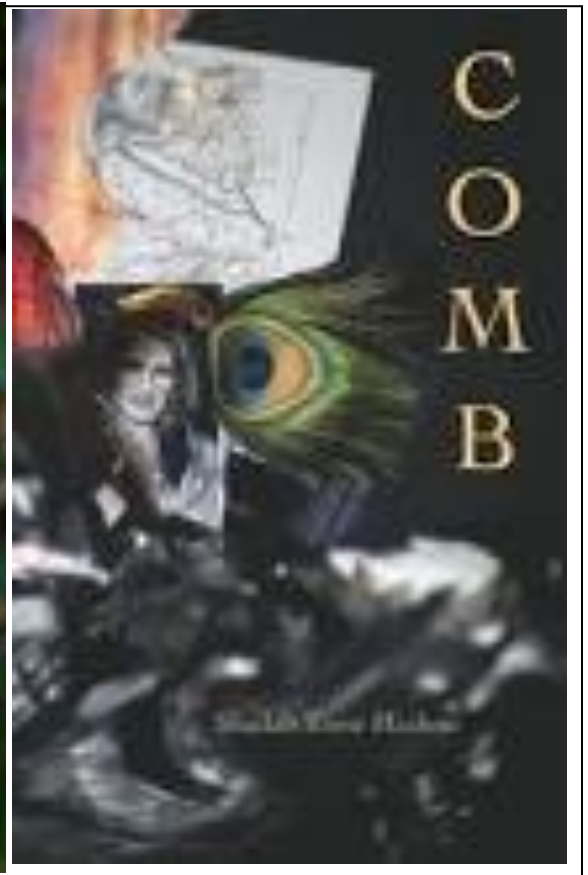


National Poetry Month
