

Materials: cereal box (or a paper bag), duct tape, tissue paper, scotch tape, string or twine

1) Attach the twine first, secure it tightly with duct tape. Fortify the top of the box with duct tape to make it sturdy.



- 2) Cut strips of tissue paper about 3 inches wide and each strip, cut a slit every half inch or so to make it more textured. That's what give the pinata a little fluff!
- 3) Wrap one strip of tissue paper around at a time. Taping it as we went! We continued the process until we reached the top.
- 4) Embellish with pom-poms or little tissue paper flowers at the top...Voila!
