

DIY CEREAL BOX PINATA

Materials: cereal box (or a paper bag), duct tape, tissue paper, scotch tape, string or twine

- 1) Attach the twine first, secure it tightly with duct tape. Fortify the top of the box with duct tape to make it sturdy.



- 2) Cut strips of tissue paper about 3 inches wide and each strip, cut a slit every half inch or so to make it more textured. That's what give the pinata a little fluff!
- 3) Wrap one strip of tissue paper around at a time. Taping it as we went! We continued the process until we reached the top.
- 4) Embellish with pom-poms or little tissue paper flowers at the top...Voila!
