

Materials:

- Light brown construction paper
- —Dark brown construction paper
- —This template (for moose eyeballs and leaves)
- —Kid scissors
- —Markers or crayons
- -Glue or gluestick
- 1. Trace and cut out your footprint on light brown paper.
- 2. Trace and cut out both handprints on dark brown paper. (Save dark brown paper scraps.)
- 3. Cut out template white circles. These are the moose's eyes. Draw irises.
- 4. Glue handprint antlers to top of foot as shown above. Glue on eyes.
- 5. Draw on nostrils and eyebrows.
- 6. Find your leftover dark brown paper and cut a strip. Your strip can be straight or crooked. This will be the twig that the moose eats!
- 7. Color leaves from template and cut them out. Glue leaves on twig. Moose are too tall to eat grass, so twigs, bark and leaves are what moose like to eat! Now you can feed a twig to your pet moose!
