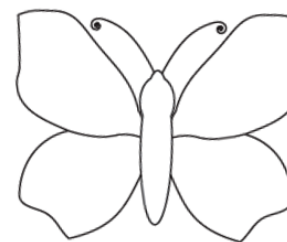


About Welcoming Week

Welcoming Week is an annual campaign and celebration to showcase the movement of communities striving to be more welcoming places for all, including immigrants. Launched in 2012 by Welcoming America and its members, Welcoming Week provides individuals and communities the opportunity to proclaim welcoming values through events and local initiatives that foster mutual understanding between immigrants and non-immigrants, as well as deeper belonging for all.

Celebrating the 10th anniversary of Welcoming Week

This year, Welcoming Week celebrates its 10th anniversary. What started as a small collection of events in U.S. communities has since expanded to reach more than 400 events annually across the world, signaling the broad commitment to welcoming values. During the week, we recognize and celebrate the people, places, and values that ensure everyone feels welcome and belongs in our communities, no matter where they come from.



Why the butterfly?

The butterfly, specifically the monarch butterfly, has become a symbol that represents the courage and resiliency of the immigrant community. We selected the butterfly as the theme for our welcome notes to remind newly arrived immigrants in San Diego that they are welcome in our city.
