### ANNOUNCEMENT

An Election will be held on March 23, 2023, on the Patio of the Carmel Valley Library located at 3919 Townsgate Dr., San Diego, CA. The Election will be held at 6:45 pm till 7:00 pm. An individual voting for a Neighborhood candidate will be required to show proof of residency in that Neighborhood. An individual voting for a Business or Investor candidate will be required to show written permission from the local business or property owner to act as their designee. A business owner or investor must also show proof of business activity or ownership of property with the Carmel Valley Planning Area.

Residential seats are for people who are at least 18 years old, currently living in Carmel Valley or PHR, and reside in the seat's district. To be an eligible candidate in the March election, the candidate must declare his or her intention to run for the seat and submit an application.

- II. THE FOLLOWING PHR DISTRICT SEAT IS UP FOR RE-ELECTION AND UNOPPOSED - PHR D2 (Adam Fox)

BALLOTS SHALL BE SEALED IN A PLAIN ENVELOPE THAT IS THEN SEALED IN A SECOND ENVELOPE. ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE SECOND ENVELOPE, THE VOTER MUST WRITE THEIR NAME, ADDRESS, THE SEAT BEING VOTED ON AND ALL INFORMATION RELEVANT TO THEIR ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE FOR THAT SEAT. BEFORE THE COUNTING OF VOTES, THE BOARD WILL REVIEW THE QUALIFICATIONS ON THE SEALED ENVELOPES FOR ELIGIBILITY. BEFORE THE OPENING OF THE INNER ENVELOPES AND THE COUNTING OF THE VOTES, ALL IDENTIFYING INFORMATION WILL BE REMOVED AND SEPARATED FROM THE BALLOTS. OBJECTIONS TO VOTER ELIGIBILITY SHOULD BE MADE BEFORE THE SECOND ENVELOPE IS OPENED AND REMOVED. ALL VOTING MATERIALS WILL BE PROVIDED.
