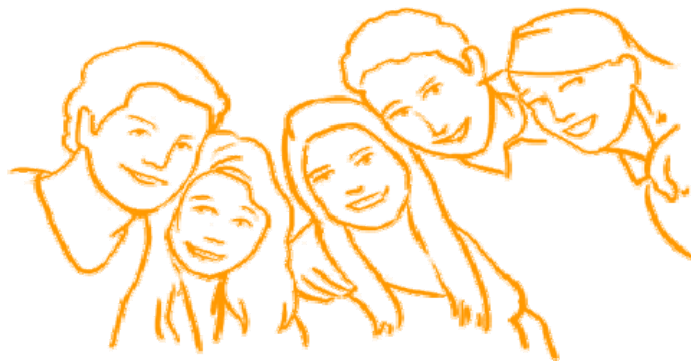


Help Youth Like You
